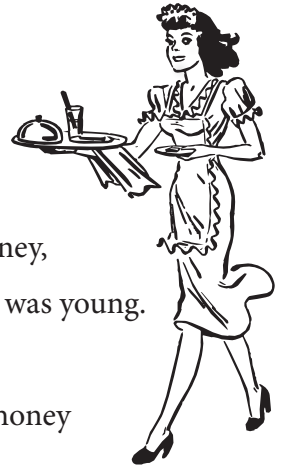

The Great Indian Bustard

The Great Indian Bustard is India's largest bird. Although it spends most of **0 B** life on the ground, it is considered to be one of **1** ___ flying birds. The male bird is more than one metre **2** ___ and weighs nearly 16 kg. Its wing span is about three metres.
